

Who Is Jesus

- I. Hooked on Jesus
 - A. We have 3 stories that we will focus on this week. Each involves Jesus using fish. Our theme will be Hooked on Jesus.
 - B. Luke 5 – Jesus call His first disciples.
 - C. Matthew 14 – Jesus feeds the crowd with 5 loaves and 2 fish.
 - D. John 21 – Jesus appears to the disciples after He has risen.

- II. Who is Jesus
 - A. At the heart of each of these stories is seeing Jesus for who He is.
 - B. He began with a call to follow Him and learn who He was. He would show the disciples and the crowd how He is the Son of God who can meet their needs. He reminds the disciples of who He is and who they would be teaching.
 - C. It is an important question that we ourselves will answer for someday. Who is Jesus?
 - D. We hope to introduce Him this week.

- III. Answer
 - A. Matthew 16:13-20
 - B. Jesus asked the disciples what others were saying about who He was. Then He asked the disciples the same question.
 - C. What is our answer? Do you know Jesus?
 - D. It no, lets talk about Him. If yes, how well? Does your life reflect that we do?

- IV. Knowing Jesus
 - A. If we know Him, do we tell others? Are we fishers of men?
 - B. If we know Him, do we help others? Are we visiting the sick, feeding the hungry, etc. Matthew 25
 - C. If we know Him, are we living for His return?
 - D. James 2:14-17 – Hearing and doing. Knowing Jesus well enough to be like Him as best we can.
